Duration: 6 months or more

- To carry out a selection of activities e.g. reading, writing letters, chatting, music, baking, cooking, gardening, playing games, accompanying resident on trips out
- To meet all reasonable needs of the resident

- Good interpersonal and communication skills
- Helpful disposition with an interest in local community
